REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS:

OPINION

We have audited the financial statements of **V.I.S.V. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) in India and are in line with the relevant laws as well as guidelines prescribed. The significant accounting policies adopted by the company are stated below:

a) Basis of preparation of Financial Statements

Method of Accounting:

The financial statements have been prepared in compliance with the accounting standards as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 (as amended). The financial statements have been prepared on going concern basis under the historical cost convention on accrual basis in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India. All assets and liabilities have been classified as current or non-current, wherever applicable as per the operating cycle of the Company and other criteria as set out in the Schedule III to the Companies Act, 2013.

Accounting Policies

Accounting policies except those specifically mentioned in the notes are consistent with those applied in the previous year.

b) System of Accounting

The company follows the mercantile system of accounting by following the accrual concept in the preparation of accounts.

c) Exceptional and Extraordinary Items

Exceptional Items

Items of income and expenses within profit or loss from ordinary activities are of such size, nature or incidence that their disclosure is relevant to explain the performance of the enterprise for the period, the nature and amount of such items are disclosed separately as exceptional items.

Extraordinary Items

Extraordinary Items are income or expenses that arise from events or transactions that are clearly distinct from the ordinary activities of the enterprise and, therefore, are not expected to recur frequently or regularly.

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d) Fixed Assets

Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition/construction, net of credit availed in respect of any duties & taxes, less accumulated depreciation. The cost also includes all pre-operative expenses and financing cost of borrowings till the commencement of commercial production.

e) Depreciation

Depreciation on Tangible Fixed Assets is provided on WDV method as per useful life prescribed in Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013. Depreciation on assets purchased/sold during the year is charged on proportionate basis.

f) Use of Estimation :

The preparation of financial statements requires estimates and assumption to be made that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities on the date of financial statements and the reported amount of revenues and expense during the reporting period. Difference between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the period in which the results are known/ materialized. These estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on ongoing basis.

g) Provisions, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets

Provisions are measured using substantial degree of estimation and are recognized when there is a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that there will be an outflow of resources to settle the obligation. Contingent Liabilities are not recognized but are disclosed in the notes wherever required. Contingent Assets are neither recognized nor disclosed in the financial statements.

h) Earnings per share

The earning considered in ascertaining the Company's E P S comprises the net profit after tax as per "Accounting Standard 20 – Earning per Share" issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The number of shares used in computing basic and diluted EPS is the weighted average number of shares outstanding during the period.

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i) **Accounting of Taxes**

Provision for taxation for the year is ascertained on the basis of assessable profits computed in accordance with the provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961.

Deferred tax is recognized, subject to the consideration of prudence, on timing difference between taxable income and accounting income that originates in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods.
